maximum impact through school principals

Top companies in Kentucky invest in leadership training, and many choose to send executives to the Center for Creative Leadership (CCL), one of the world's leading institutes for leadership education.

The Kentucky Chamber Foundation has developed a strategic partnership with CCL, using its executive training expertise for school leaders. We call the Chamber/CCL partnership the Leadership Institute for School Principals.

In 2011, the Foundation sent 47 principals from across the Commonwealth to the Institute. The group attended a three-day training retreat in Greensboro, N.C., followed by four days of training at the Kentucky Chamber headquarters in Frankfort.

Now the goal is to expand the program and offer it to all new public- and private-school principals for the next five years. Each year, roughly 150 principals are named to their positions at elementary, middle and high schools in Kentucky.

This is the very best way for a business to make a direct impact on education at the local level, empowering school principals to lead their schools and make a difference in the lives of kids.



The Kentucky Chamber Foundation is contacting business leaders in every county in Kentucky, asking them to get involved in improving education by sponsoring one or more local principals. It costs about \$9,000 per principal to attend the Leadership Institute, which includes seven days of intense training as well as follow-up with a personal coach.
